

USA (2007) 128 minutes

France/Germany (2008) 117 minutes Director: Philippe Claudel

As she struggles to adjust to her freedom she comes to live with her sister Léa, who was a teenager when Juliette was sentenced. The sisters slowly rediscover their relationship while disturbing questions hang over them. Why did Juliette commit

#### 23rd September IL DIVO

Italy / France (2008) 110 minutes Director: Paolo Sorrentino

Paolo Sorrentino, a leading light in the Italian new wave of directors, gives us a bird'seye view of the controversial post-war figure of Giulio Andreotti. Leader of the centrist

Christian Democratic Party, Andreotti became Prime Minister of Italy seven times and remains a senator for life. Andreotti, a man with close ties to the Vatican, had his reputation tarnished when he was tried for and subsequently acquitted of Mafia ties and, later, the murder of an Italian journalist. The film won the Jury Prize at Cannes in 2008 and is in English and Italian with subtitles.



Poland (2007) 122 minutes Director: Andrzej Wajda



Director Andrzej Wajda takes a unique dramatic examination on the tragic story of Katyn. In the spring of 1943 the advancing German army uncovered 4,400 bodies in the Katyn Forest near Smolensk. The majority of the dead were Polish officers and

soldiers executed by Stalin's secret police. Among them was Wajda's father. Working from real life accounts and a novel by


Andrzej Mularczyk, Katyn tells the story through the eyes of the women, mothers, wives and daughters forever separated from their loved ones by the massacres. A provoking and






Frau Traude Krueger is an elderly piano teacher who gives lessons at a women's prison. She teaches a guard and a few women prisoners while looking for other potential students.

She finds the aggressive and rebellious Jenny, a former child prodigy at the piano. Frau Krueger discovers Jenny's brutal and terrible past and resolves to prepare her for a competition. As the training begins Frau Krueger relives her



wartime romance and the self-destructive Jenny must prepare for 4 minutes of recognition at the Berlin Opera House. The film is in German with English subtitles.

## **ENCOUNTERS AT THE END** OF THE WORLD

USA (2007) 99 minutes Director: Werner Herzog



This is a fascinating and visually entrancing documentary by the veteran filmmaker Werner Herzog. The filmmaker travels to the Antarctica community of McMurdo Station. The station is

the headquarters of the National Science Foundation. In the Antarctic summer it is home to eleven hundred men and women who have dedicated themselves to scientific study in this hostile landscape. Over the course of his film Herzog examines some of the insightful and sometimes weird experiences of the marine biologists, physicists and truck drivers who work there. A study of human nature set against the awe-inspiring backdrop of the natural world.

In Edwardian England of 1904, Henslowe Fisk and his father Horatio attend a lecture on reincarnation given by the Swami Nala Prash. There they meet Dean Spanley from the colonies. Henslowe, after

coincidental encounters with Spanley, begins a series of dinners with him. There, after several glasses of wine. Dean begins, with clarity, to recount events from a previous life. As these recollections progress they begin



to have a personal and profound effect on the father and son. The cold and hard shell of the era finds a warm and cathartic heart in this quirky comedy starring Peter O'Toole.

After 30 years of marriage, Inge, in her 60s, embarks on a passionate affair with 76 year-old Karl. She is now torn between the husband she loves dearly and the man who ignites a spark of life in her.

Inge feels her youth re-awakened while Karl sees the relationship as his last chance at happiness. Dresen examines the emotional and moral impact on the three characters as the consequences grow ever more complicated.

## **FUGITIVE PIECES**

Canada/Greece (2007) 104 minutes Director: Jeremy Podeswa





A powerful and graceful adaptation of a best-selling novel by Canadian poet Anne Michael. The story begins in Poland in 1942. Athos, a Greek archaeologist, finds a Jewish boy, Jakob, who has witnessed his

parents murdered by the Nazis and his sister abducted. Athos smuggles the boy to Greece. Ultimately the pair move to Canada. Here Jakob, now an adult, becomes increasingly haunted by the past and his missing sister. This terrible burden prevents him reaching out to the world and only a woman's love can lead him out of the darkness. A heart-warming and unforgettable story.
